INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN HEALTH CENTERS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Internship Program in Health Centers is aimed at university students interested in expanding their studies through professional internships in health centers. Through this program, students will be able to learn about the operation of a Spanish health center, benefiting from the interaction with professional health teams.

CONTENTS

THEORETICAL AGENDA:

- The scientific foundations of medicine
- Clinical skills: preparation of a clinical history. Diagnosis, prognosis and treatment
- Communication skills: the importance of communication and empathy with the patient
- Public health and health systems
- Sources of clinical and biomedical information
- · Research and scientific thinking

PRACTICAL AGENDA:

- Activities in emergencies and intensive care unit: knowledge of clinical history, examination in emergencies, complementary tests, organization of the service, etc.
- Activity in the pediatrics area: neonatal area, outpatient consultation and room pass in the morning.
- Activity in the area of obstetrics and gynecology: emergency consultation, outpatient consultation and surgical area
- Activity in the area of internal medicine: outpatient consultation, room pass, specialty consultation (area of hemodynamics and interventional radiology)
- Activity in the surgical area: outpatient surgery consultation, outpatient traumatology consultation, knowledge of the different surgical techniques in the operating room
- Activities in the training area: tumor committee (weekly periodic meetings), pharmacy committee (monthly meetings), multidisciplinary clinical case study committee (weekly meetings), quality committee (weekly meetings).

METHODOLOGY

All CLM classes follow the integration of skills, student involvement in tasks, group dynamics and pragmatic and socio-cultural value of the topics. The homework should be oriented towards the integration of students in an immersion situation in addition to personal work.





EVALUATION

- To have the right to be evaluated, attendance at tutorials with the CLM tutor is mandatory.
- Students' attention, participation and attendance at joint seminars and individual interviews will be valued with 20% of the final grade.
- 50% of the final grade will be obtained through the report that the external tutor will issue on the work carried out at the health center.
- The remaining 30% will depend on the results obtained in the report that students must present in writing and orally at the end of the course.
