GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY - 22.5 HOURS

HISTORY OF SPAIN

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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This course examines the most significant political, economic, social, and cultural events from the mid-twentieth century to present-day Spain. After an introductory topic explaining the background and precedents of the Franco regime, the course will focus on an in-depth analysis of Franco's military dictatorship and the process through which Spain transitioned to democracy and consolidated its democratic system up to the present day.

CONTENTS

- Topic 1. Spain at the Beginning of the Twentieth Century and the Second Republic (1931–1936)
- Topic 2. The Spanish Civil War (1936–1939)
- Topic 3. Franco's Spain I (1940s and 1950s)
- Topic 4. Franco's Spain II (1960s and 1970s)
- Topic 5. From the Spanish Transition to Present-Day Spain

METHODOLOGY

In this course, the teaching approach will be based on a combination of theoretical classes and extensive student participation, as students will have previously read some of the readings provided by the instructor at home.

All classes promote an integrated skills approach, involving students in tasks through group dynamics and emphasizing the pragmatic and sociocultural value of the topics covered.

The development of this course includes the analysis of a variety of film materials, historical texts, and songs.

EVALUATION

To be eligible for assessment, students must attend at least 80% of class sessions.

- Students' attention, participation, and interest will account for 25% of the final grade.
- 25% of the final grade will be based on the different written and oral exercises completed throughout the course.
- The remaining 50% will depend on the results obtained in the written exam administered at the end of the course.
