INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN HEALTH CENTERS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Healthcare Center Internship Program is designed for university students interested in expanding their academic experience through professional internships in healthcare facilities. Through this program, students will gain insight into the operation of a Spanish healthcare center while benefiting from interaction with professional healthcare teams.

Practical Content

- Activities in the Emergency Department and Intensive Care Unit:
 - Understanding of medical records, emergency room examinations, complementary diagnostic tests, service organization, and related procedures.
- Activities in the Pediatrics Department:
 - Neonatal care, outpatient consultations, and morning ward rounds.
- Activities in the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department:
 - Emergency consultations, outpatient consultations, and surgical area activities.
- Activities in the Internal Medicine Department:
 - Outpatient consultations, ward rounds, and specialist consultations (including the hemodynamics and interventional radiology areas).
- Activities in the Surgical Department:
 - Surgical outpatient consultations, orthopedic outpatient consultations, and introduction to different surgical techniques performed in the operating room.

METHODOLOGY

The professor will establish a tutorial and personalized support system with students throughout their clinical training period. Therefore, at the beginning of the program, the professor will work together with each student to design the necessary strategies to achieve the proposed objectives.

EVALUATION

- To be eligible for evaluation, attendance at the joint seminars and the two tutorials with the CLM tutor is mandatory, as well as the submission of the signed attendance sheet.
- Attention, participation, and attendance at the joint seminars and individual meetings will account for 20% of the final grade.
- 50% of the final grade will be based on the report issued by the external tutor regarding the work carried out at the healthcare center.

- The remaining 30% will depend on the results obtained in the report that students must submit both in written and oral form at the end of the course.
