SPEAKING AND WRITING SKILLS 1 (A1)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The course will be made up of a small number of students, taught in sequences of 2 hours a day and is developed in parallel with the subject of Grammar Level . In this class, oral and written skills will be mainly addressed to achieve the profile of this level.

CONTENTS

- Address someone: Hola + name.
- Give and request personal information: name, nationality, activity, age.
- Greet and respond to a greeting. Hola, Buenos días / tardes / noches.
- Informal introductions. Soy..., Este es...
- Identification and reproduction of the timbre of vowel phonemes: /a, e, i, o, u/.
- Existence: hay.
- Locate: en, entre, cerca, lejos, a la derecha, al lado, al final, al norte, en el centro (de).
- Weather.
- Request information about vocabulary: ¿Qué significa ?
- Main characteristics of the predominant syllable.
- Division into syllables
- Spanish speaking countries.
- Describe people.
- Identify: este, ese, aquel.
- Physical appearance.
- Identification of the consonant system.
- Relationship between sounds and spellings.
- Express necessity: tener que.
- Lists of prices and products.
- Shopping.
- Express location.
- Highlight an aspect (lo que más/menos... es...)
- Describe your neighborhood.
- Give instructions.
- Express tastes and interests: gustar, interesar + noun or infinitive. Recreational activities.
- Express desire: querer + infinitive.
- Express preference: prefiero...
- Request objects.
- Offer and invite.
- Meals and bars.
- · Express habitual actions of daily life.





CONTENTS

- Express frequency.
- Place actions in time.
- Express time: qué hora, a qué hora, cuándo.
- · Daily habits and customs.
- Express abilities and character.

METHODOLOGY

Given the immersive nature of teaching in the CLM, during class instruction the student develops the strategies, linguistic and socio-cultural knowledge that allow them to face these transactions, social interactions and texts outside the classroom, always connecting said personal experience with class instruction.

EVALUATION

Exit test (40% of the final grade)

• Written test (2 class hours)

Continuous evaluation (60% of the final grade)

- Participation in class (30% of the continuous evaluation). Participation is understood as active and productive, that is, showing interest and progress.
- Out-of-class tasks (30% of the continuous evaluation). Included here, for example, are exercises that are done at home to correct in class or preparation tasks or tasks after class activities.
