SPEAKING AND WRITING SKILLS 4 (B1.1)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The course will be made up of a small number of students, taught in sequences of 2 hours a day and is developed in parallel with the subject of Grammar Level 4.

CONTENTS

- Talk about habits in the present. Relate past experiences. Talk about the beginning and duration of an action. Locate an action in time.
- Talk about prohibitions and obligations. Talk about habits of the Spanish.
- Talk about habits, customs and circumstances in the past. Argue and debate.
- · Recommend and advise. Give instructions. Describe a scene in the past and present
- Get along on the phone. Taking and leaving messages by phone
- Tell stories in the past tense
- Ask for and grant things, favors and permission. Justify yourself, give thanks.
- Talk about future actions and situations. Express conditions. Formulate hypotheses.
- Relate in the present. Summarize an argument. Tell jokes.

METHODOLOGY

Given the immersive nature of teaching in the CLM, during class instruction the student develops the strategies, linguistic and socio-cultural knowledge that allow them to face these transactions, social interactions and texts outside the classroom, always connecting said personal experience with class instruction.

EVALUATION

Exit test (40% of the final grade)

- Written and oral test. Midterm exam (20%)
- Oral and oral test. Final exam (20%)

Continuous evaluation (60% of the final grade)

- Active and productive participation in class (20%).
- Three written assignments outside of class (20%)

Oral presentation in front of the class the last week of the course (20%)
