

LEVEL TEST AND LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students take a mandatory language level test at the beginning of their program.

Students at any level of Spanish proficiency can enrol in Intensive Spanish Language Courses (CILE) which are offered monthly from January to December at levels 1-Beginner through 8-Superior.

Students who place into in levels 1-4 are able to enrol in the Spanish Language and Culture (CLCE) Program with content courses taught in English.

Students in levels 5-6 may enrol in the CLCE Program with content courses taught in Spanish.

Students in levels 7-9 may enrol in the Hispanic Studies (CEH) Program taught entirely in Spanish.

The program for Spanish Language Courses complies with the content description set out in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
