Students have the option to secure their own housing in furnished flats shared with other Centro de Lenguas Modernas students. The rent for shared flats typically costs approximately €200 - €300 per month (not including utilities).

The option of living in a shared flat is managed directly between the student and their property owner/manager. Students who choose to secure their own housing in this manner take full responsibility for all costs incurred including rent, all utilities (electricity, water, heat, Internet), meals, etc. and will pay a deposit to cover any damages. Students are encouraged to spend their first days in Granada in a hotel/hostal while they visit the available flats and process the necessary paperwork and payments.

Due to the dates and the duration of the J-Term Program we do not recommend that students attempt to find their own housing for this brief stay.
