



Response and prevention plan for COVID-19

April 2022

Due to Covid-19, a series of preventative measures needs to be adopted which inevitably have a major impact on society and, consequently, on the Centro de Lenguas Modernas (UGR).

The Centro de Lenguas Modernas is constantly analyzing the health alert situation, as required by the COVID scenario, and has the firm resolve and commitment to ensure that all activities, both current and future, can be carried out with proper guarantees in terms of health and safety. Logically, this plan also calls for individual responsibility, since only the joint action of people and institutions will yield effective results in the fight against the spread of the SARS-COV-2 virus.

The preventive measures against Covid-19 adopted by CLM for the return to on-site activity were drawn up by our Occupational Risk Prevention Service.

With regard to teaching activities, CLM follows the guidelines established by the University of Granada and the pertinent authorities.

- As a general rule, personal distance should be respected in crowded spaces.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the workplace and corresponding equipment shall be reinforced and natural ventilation shall be ensured for as long as possible depending on the time of year.
- Work spaces shall be ventilated for a minimum of 10 minutes, opening doors and windows whenever possible to renew the air inside. In work spaces with no windows, care should be taken to keep the door open.
- Servicing of all air-conditioning equipment to check on filter cleaning and filter renewal if necessary. The airflow direction will be adjusted to avoid possible propagation of the virus.
- Sharing phones, headphones, pens and other items should be avoided as much as possible.

In the classroom:

- The use of face masks is not mandatory, but recommended.
- Prior to the start of the course, students will receive instructions on safety and hygiene protocols.
- After each class, the classroom will be ventilated.
- Should a student be infected but asymptomatic, health authorities state that he/she does not have to keep quarantine and may attend class provided an FFP2-type face mask is worn.
- If students are infected with symptoms, they will be excused from class and their teachers will be in contact with them to send them the material and tasks that will be carried out in class during their absence. In addition, they have the possibility of arranging a tutorial with their teacher once they have recovered.

The Centro de Lenguas Modernas will appoint a person to be responsible for its Covid-19 protocol. The ultimate responsibility will lie, in all cases, with the CLM Directorate.
